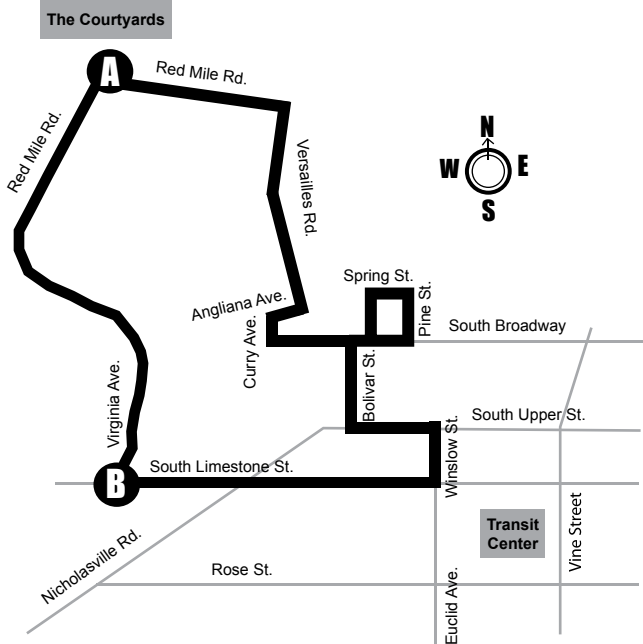

True Blue Express

Effective August 24<sup>th</sup>, 2009



The “True Blue Express” runs Monday through Friday from 6:50 a.m. until 2:20 p.m., and 3:00 p.m. until 6:15 p.m. It stops in 25 minute intervals at the University Courtyards Apartments and at any LexTran bus stop along its Route.

*Route 31 - True Blue Express operates only when the University of Kentucky is in session.*

## FARE INFORMATION

### Regular Fare: \$1.00

Passengers 19 and older

### Students/Youths: 80 cents

valid I.D. required

### Seniors: 50 cents

Passengers 62 and older are eligible for this fare by presenting a LexTran ID card. Photo ID cards may be obtained at the Transit Center on Vine Street, Monday through Friday from 8:30 A.M. to 4:00 P.M. for a \$5.00 charge. Proof of age is required.

### Senior Citizens with Disabilities: 50 cents

valid I.D. required

### Persons with Disabilities: 50 cents

A LexTran ID or Medicare Card is required to receive this discounted fare.

### Medicare Cardholders\*: 50 cents

valid I.D. required

### Children: Free

six years old and under when accompanied by a fare paying adult (maximum five children per fare paying adult.)

### Transfers\*\*: Free

### Tokens: \$1.00

\*Note: A valid Medicare card qualifies applicant for Senior bus fare or a LexTran ID Card.

\*\*Transfers cannot be used on the same route.

## TARIFAS

### Tarifa regular : \$1.00

las personas mayores de 19 años

### Tarifa de estudiantes: 80 centavos

(de entre 6 a 18 años);  
presentando una tarjeta de identificación.

### Tarifa para personas mayores: 50 centavos:

Personas de 62 años pueden disfrutar de esta tarifa presentando una tarjeta de identificación otorgada por LexTran. Una identificación con foto puede obtenerse en el Transit Center en Vine Street de lunes a viernes desde las 8:30 a.m. hasta las 4:00 p.m. por solo \$5.00 dólares. Se requiere algún tipo de identificación que pruebe la edad.

### Niños: Gratis

Los niños menores de 5 años no pagan siempre que vayan acompañados de un adulto que pague la tarifa (máximo de 5 niños por adulto).

Transferencia: Gratis: El pase mensual de LexTran permite hacer viajes sin límite a bajos precios durante todo el mes.

## Rules of the Bus

To make bus travel comfortable and safe for everyone, please follow these rules for bus travel:

- Smoking, eating, drinking, pets (other than service animals - any animal individually trained to work or perform tasks for an individual with a disability) are prohibited.
- Talking with the driver while underway, or riding with the driver for visitation are not permitted.
- Radios (except with headphones), vulgar language, and alcoholic beverages are prohibited.
