

All LexTran Buses Now Provide a Ride to Shelter for Victims of Domestic Violence.

Victims of domestic violence may now board any LexTran bus and say, "I need a ride to shelter." Bus drivers will then immediately enact the ***Ride to Shelter*** procedures modeled after the YMCA's Safe Place program. Next, LexTran radio operators will notify the route supervisor, who will then pick up the victim(s) and ensure they are transported to the Bluegrass Domestic Violence Program Shelter. Children who may be with adults fleeing domestic violence will also be transported.



LexTran employees will not act as counselors. Their sole responsibility is to enact and fulfill the ***Ride to Shelter*** procedure. LexTran supervisors will not leave the victim(s) until the BDVP's intake procedure begins.
