- Can accommodate up to 800 lbs.
- Special lift barrier and belt for maximum safety
- All buses have 3-point tie downs and most have shoulder belts that control forward and side movements
- Maximum 2 wheelchairs per bus (no 3-wheel scooters)
- Arrive up to 15 minutes before bus arrives

# LEXTRAN's Wheelchair Accessible Bus Service

It's Easy!



**1.** After bus has come to a complete stop, make sure you are five feet away as driver sets up and lowers wheelchair lift.



**3.** Set your wheelchair brake. Your driver will fasten the safety belt and raise the lift's outer barrier before raising platform to floor level of bus.



**6.** As before, move into position onto platform, facing outward from the bus. Set your wheelchair brake and your driver will make sure safety belt is fastened.



**2.** Facing outward from the bus, wheel backward onto the lift platform. The bus driver will assist you.



**4.** When lift is even with bus floor and no longer in motion, wheel backward off lift and lock into bus' wheelchair-designated space. Enjoy the ride!



**5.** To exit, wait until bus has stopped completely and wheel to the door of the coach. Your driver will deploy the lift at this time.



**7.** Once platform is at ground level and your driver has lowered the outer barrier, release wheelchair brake and wheel forward off of lift.
